



Beginning Crochet

Crochet is the new “it” craft. Knitters and needle arts beginners alike are venturing into this versatile craft and loving it. Come and get hooked!

In this beginning level crochet class, you will learn basic chaining techniques, the single, double, and triple crochet stitches, crocheting in the round, changing colors and simple edgings. In addition, each student will learn how to read basic pattern abbreviations.

The pattern for the final project, determined by individuals in the class, will come from the required text: *The Happy Hooker* by Debbi Stoller.

Yarn: One skein of Plymouth Encore - or - one ball of Cascade 220 superwash yarn. *NOTE: Choose a medium to light color!*

Hook: G (4 mm)
