



Beginning Crochet

Crochet is the new “it” craft. Knitters and needle arts beginners alike are venturing into this versatile craft and loving it. Come on—get hooked!

In this beginning level crochet class, you will learn basic chaining techniques, the single, double, and triple crochet stitches, crocheting in the round, changing colors and simple edgings. In addition, each student will learn how to read basic pattern abbreviations.

The final project, determined by individuals in the class, will come from the required text: Teach Yourself Visually Crochet by Kim Werker and Cecily Keim

Required Materials: Please purchase your materials at Knit Knack prior to the first class.

Reference Guide: *Teach Yourself Visually Crochet* by Kim Werker and Cecily Keim

Yarn: One skein of Cascade 220. *NOTE: Choose a medium to light color!*

Hook: US size G (4 mm) or H (5 mm)
