



Katarina (Beginning Sweater)

This is a beginning sweater knitting class that offers a sweater that's out of the ordinary. Seemingly an intermediate project, students need only have mastery of the knit and purl—they will learn Full-Fashion Shaping, personalized fitting, measuring gauge, provisional cast on, and a number of helpful tips to enhance any knitter's repertoire of knitting skills.

Materials—Please purchase at Knit Knack!

Pattern or Book: Julie Weisenberger's (Cocoknits) "Katarina" pattern

Finished Measurements: 33-36, (36 -39, 39-42, 42-46)

Yarn & Quantity: 7 (7, 8, 9) balls of Jo Sharp DK tweed (85% wool, 10% silk, 5% cashmere—50g/147 yards or any DK weight yarn.

Needles: US size 7-32" circular needle or size needed to obtain the correct gauge.

Notions: stitch markers, tapestry needle, about one yard of smooth waste yarn

Gauge: 16 sts and 24 rows = 4" square in St st. (4 sts per inch)
Please work up your gauge swatch prior to the first class!
