



Moorish Mosaic Afghan

A single motif that morphs from a hexagon to an octagon is the core of this stunning afghan. A gorgeous interplay of color gives the blanket the look of Moorish tiles. Two support motifs—a small square and a triangle—are the mortar that hold the octagons together. A chart will let you follow Lisa's brilliant color scheme, or you can devise your own.

The class is designed to teach how to crochet each motif and put the afghan motifs together, it is up to you to finish the afghan on your own or meet with your other classmates and have a crochet-a-long!

Materials (please purchase at Knit Knack prior to the start of class):

Pattern: Interweave Crochet Magazine Fall 2009, design by Lisa Naskrent

Yarn: Cascade 220, Cascade 220 Superwash, Plymouth Encore or Berroco Comfort

- 4 skeins of main color
- 2 skeins each of 5 complimentary colors

Needles: One Size I crochet hook

Notions: 8 locking stitch markers, tapestry needle
