



Bunad Mukluks

These fun and funky Inuit-style felted mukluks incorporate beautiful Norwegian embellishments such as embroidery and fringed, multi-colored tassels, reminiscent of the folk styles of the past. The pattern knits up as huge ‘socks’ and then are felted to size (children’s sizes 11, 12, 12½, 13, and 1; women’s sizes 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10). The fringed tassels are part of the class instruction; however other embellishments are left to the individual style of each participant.

Materials (please purchase at Knit Knack prior to the start of class):

Pattern Book: Folk Style (Interweave Press)

Yarn: Cascade 220 (worsted weight) 100% wool

- 2 skeins (380 yards) for children’s sizes
- 3 skeins (570 yards) for women’s sizes

Needles: one set of five DPNs, US size 8 (or size necessary to obtain gauge)

Notions: stitch markers, stitch holders, tapestry needle and one pair of Fiber Trends slipper soles to match foot length (note: darker colors can be achieved by using fabric dye).

Gauge: 18 stitches and 24 rows = 4” in stockinette stitch (before felting)
