Wow! Pam Allen's "Portland Tweed Vest" is as beautiful as it is easy . . . okay, maybe the pattern offers a small challenge, but just enough to keep you interested!

Gorgeous in any tweed, it is sure to be a winter staple. And no sleeves make this sweetie a very quick knit indeed.

Finished Size: 31½" 35" 38¼" 41¾" 45"

Materials—please purchase at Knit Knack

Yarn Suggestions: 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) balls of Jo Sharp Tweed, Kathmandu Tweed, or Debbie Bliss Luxury Tweed

Pattern: Classic Elite "Autumn" (book 1)

Needles: U.S. size 4, 5, and 6 (or sizes necessary to obtain the correct gauge)

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders (or waste yarn), a cable needle, and four buttons

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch on largest needles;
 20 sts and 30 rows = 4" in 1 x 1 rib (stretched) with medium needles.
