You’ve seen lushly cabled sweaters to knit, but are they too much of a good thing? The Susie is just right: A vertical band of the most of the most complex-looking (but not so difficult to knit) cabling is all this hoodie needs to catch the eye and satisfy your cable needle. Don’t miss the hem detailing—this sweater has you looking great coming and going.

Sizes: L 1X 2X 3X 4X
 Finished Measurements: 44” 48” 52” 56” 60” (with front bands overlapped)

Materials—please purchase at Knit Knack!

- Pattern:** Jillian Moreno & Amy R. Singer’s *More Big Girl Knits*
- Yarn:** 18 (18, 20, 21, 23) balls of Jo Sharp Aran Tweed (104 yds)
- Needles:** One US size 8 + 16”, 32”, 60” and size 7-32”
- Notions:** Seven (7) stitch markers, cable needle, waste yarn, and a tapestry needle
- Gauge:** **17 sts and 25 rows = 4” in stockinette stich on larger needles. Please have your gauge swatch done before class**
