



## Titicaca Sweater

Okay, so the dreadful name *Titicaca* conjures up a playground scene where a group of third graders belligerently throw around the term because it sounds like a dirty word. Really, Titicaca is a beautiful lake in Peru—the view of which will leave you breathless.

Why not conjure up your advanced beginner knitting skills to create this darling sweater? It's likely that it already has a place in your wardrobe—and you can name it whatever you want!

This is a great first sweater for any new knitter who wants to grow her skills to include sizing and gauge, pattern literacy, increasing and decreasing, garment construction, and blocking.

**Finished Size:** 32.5" (34.5", 36.5", 38.5", 40.25")

**Materials—please purchase at Knit Knack!**

**Yarn:** 11 (12, 12, 13, 13) hanks of the Mirasol Project “Hacho” variegated yarn. If variegated yarns aren't your thing, consider Filature di Crosa's “Zara,” Cascade's “Dolce,” Jo Sharp's “Silk Georgette” or any DK weight yarn.

**Pattern:** Jane Ellison's *Mirasol Collection* (Book One)

**Needles:** US size 6 (4mm) and US size 5 (3.75mm)

**Notions:** four buttons

**Gauge:** 22 sts and 30 rows = a 4-inch square using larger needles
